Protocol

1. The order of the candidates (left to right) was chosen at random.
 - a. Order of responses to Question 1: Candidates 1 to 11 (from left to right)
 - b. Order of responses to Question 2: Candidates 5 to 4 (from left to right)
 - c. Order of responses to Question 3: Candidates 9 to 8 (from left to right)
2. Candidates will be given up to 2 minutes to answer each question.
3. The audience will be given the opportunity to pose a question to a particular candidate by putting their question on a piece of paper; these questions will be gathered during Items 4, 5, and 6 of the agenda. From these a number will be chosen and asked of the candidates.
4. Candidates will have 1 minute to answer a question that has been directed to them from an audience participant.
5. Candidates will be given 1 minute each for a summary statement.

The meeting should take about 2 hours given the number of candidates (11) and the time allotted for the questions.
